Beginning Memorial Day weekend, Camp Jeep On The Road kicks off in Virginia Beach, Va., May 27-29. The tour continues to the following cities throughout the summer: Atlanta, June 11-12; Milwaukee, June 25-26; Buffalo, N.Y., July 9-10; Grand Rapids, Mich., July 23-24; Houston, August 27-28; San Diego, September 10-11; and Denver, September 24-25. Each two-day weekend (Saturday and Sunday) event is free of charge for owners and non-owners alike.

Camp Jeep On The Road offers a "Trail RatedTM" off-road course that will allow guests to navigate through obstacles such as steep grades, rocky trails, switchbacks and log crossing in a Jeep Wrangler, Liberty or Grand Cherokee under the guidance of a trained driving instructor. The street course will offer everyday driving tips, including safe acceleration, as well as steering and braking techniques, on a variety of surfaces. Each driving program conveys safety and educational messages in a fun, interactive environment.

In addition to on-road and off-road test drives, Camp Jeep On The Road showcases a variety of Jeep lifestyle activities, including mountain biking, Quattro bungee jumping and wall climbing. The "Camp Kids" area gives future Jeepers the opportunity to drive "Power Wheels" miniature Jeep vehicles.

Jeep owners will receive special access to the Jeep Owners Playground, where they will have the chance to test their own vehicles on some of the most popular obstacles, including some of the Jeep "Trail RatedTM" elements.

Camp Jeep Poconos is for Jeep Lovers

This year's Camp Jeep is in the Pocono Mountains – the farthest east and farthest north the event has ever been held. The air show is a first for the event. The Jeep Memphis Belle Tour is Friday, August 12 at the Pocono Mountain Airport. In addition to a B-17, the air show will include a P-51 Mustang and a pair of P-47 Thunderbolts. The tour is named for the nickname of the B-17 Flying Fortress bomber that became a legend for surviving 25 missions during WWII.

Popular elements of past Camp Jeep events remain, including the Jeep 101 course, which is designed to teach off-highway driving, safety skills and demonstrate the Trail Rated capabilities of the full line of Jeep vehicles. Participants are paired with experienced trail guides as they navigate steep grades and tackle challenges, such as large rocks, log crossings, sand and other off-highway obstacles. Once they master Jeep vehicle capabilities, they have a chance to navigate various levels of 4x4 trails in their own Jeep vehicles.

In addition, Camp Jeep offers more than 150 activities for the entire family. The Kids Village features arts and crafts and a driving course with miniature Jeep vehicles. The Sports and Adventure Village features a variety of outdoor adventure sports, including mountain biking, climbing, hiking, fly-casting and even scuba diving. Jeep King of Mountains

For the first time, the Jeep King of the Mountain series will be held in conjunction with two Jeep brand owner events: the Camp Jeep On The Road event in Grand Rapids, Mich., July 23-24, and Camp Jeep Poconos.

The Jeep King of the Mountain Series features some of the world's top mountain bikers competing head-to-head to capture the King of the Mountain title and a share of the record prize purse, which tops \$100,000, and the keys to a new 2006 Jeep Commander. Commander, which arrives in dealerships this fall, is the first Jeep vehicle with three rows of seats

An elite field of international professional racers – six women and six men – have been pre-qualified to participate in the Jeep King of the Mountain Series. The balance of the 16-athlete field – two men and two women – will qualify for each event in the Series based on points earned in National Off-Road Bicycling Association (NORBA) events, allowing these wildcard entrants a chance to compete against the best of the best for a shot at the coveted title.

A national audience will be able to view the King of the Mountain Series on CBS Sports and through nationally syndicated television. The first two one-hour specials will be nationally syndicated during the June, July and August time period. The finals will air on CBS Sports in October 2005.
